Our plan is to run many extracurricular drumming circles both on Campus as method of self-expression and commercially at functions.

Drums require a lot of maintenance, students must be transported to the various drumming venues and a drumming teacher is required to make the process work. The costs that we have produced below to enable us to run drumming sessions for an entire year.

## ESTIMATED COST

<b>Running a Student Drumming Circle Annually</b>	
<b>Item of work</b>	<b>Cost</b>
Purchase and maintenance of drums	5,000
Transport of drums to venues	2,500
Transport of students to venues	3,500
Feeding students at drumming sessions	2,000
Payment for drumming teacher – 30 sessions @ R200 per session	6,000
<b>Total</b>	<b>19,000</b>
