Greening of the second quadrangle into a garden with indigenous plants, herbs and medicinal plants in order to create the potential for a nursery of indigenous plants, herbs for sale and medicines.

RATIONALE

The pictures are of the quadrangle and clearly show the size and the old fishpond in the middle. The idea is to redesign the fish pond and fill it with composted earth and plant herbs.

Apart from those that are indigenous, much of the existing foliage will be removed. Medicinal plants will be grown around the three walls of the quadrangle, the beds being one metre wide. The lawn area, apart from strategically placed paths, will be filled with indigenous plants.

The walls surrounding the quadrangle will be painted and the door that can clearly be seen repaired
